

MISSION

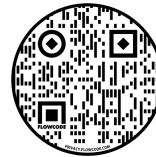

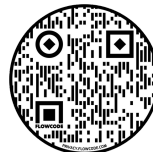

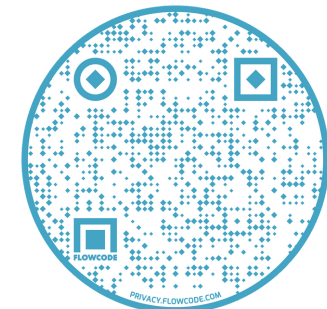
